EXPLANATORY NOTES

- **Note 1:** During the "Save This Place" fundraising campaign, all donations that are directed to "General Account", or otherwise unrestricted, will be directed to "Land Acquisition Account".
- Note 2: Natural Heritage Plan work was partially funded by a grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation in 2017. The work was completed in 2018 with the rebate of HST payments in 2019 leaving a balance of \$715. That money was moved back to the General Account leaving a small amount to keep the sub-account active.
- **Note 3**: Some properties qualified for the Conservation Land Tax Incentive Program (CLTIP) and tax overpayments were rebated. Taxes for all properties in 2019 = \$543.53.
- **Note 4**: In addition to operating funds in the Stewardship Account, the LC-KFLA has established the Natural Areas Protection Fund at the Community Foundation for Kingston & Area. This endowment fund provides annual grants for property stewardship. As of December 31, 2019, the fund's market value was \$86,969.38.
- **Note 5**: A \$5,000 grant from Nature Canada is to increase the LC-KFLA's outreach work in the region. The balance of this grant will be used in 2020.
- Note 6: Fourth Lake Nature Reserve was purchased for \$157,500. A first installment \$67,500 was made April 29, 2019. The balance of \$90,000 will be paid in three annual \$30,000 installments no later than April 29, 2022. The remaining liabilities are for the Nature Canada grant (\$5,000) described in Note 5, and a Community Foundation Grant received December 20, 2019 (\$3,650) to establish methodology for managing "Passport to Nature" as an annual program.
- **Note 7:** Two new properties were acquired in 2019. Fourth Lake Nature Reserve (see Note 6) and Mast Van Dongen Nature Reserve. The appraised values of these two properties total \$236,000 in 2019.

Financial Review Statement
